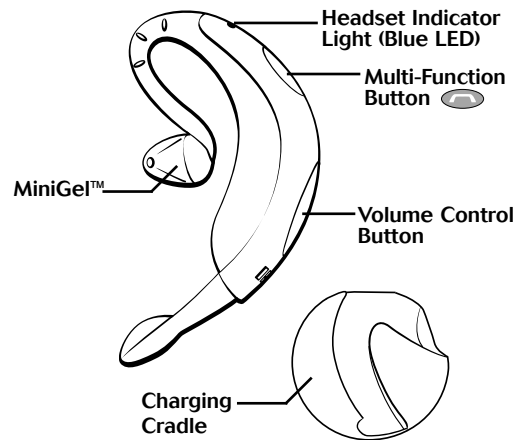


IMPORTANT! READ THIS FIRST

JABRA® FreeSpeak™ BT200 QUICK START GUIDE

For Most Bluetooth™ Phones



BEFORE USING YOUR HEADSET

1 Check phone compatibility

This version of FreeSpeak is compatible with most Bluetooth phones (version 1.1 or higher) with headset or hands-free profile. Ensure that your phone has Bluetooth capability by either visiting your phone manufacturer's web site or our web site. (JABRA also provides FreeSpeak versions for most non-Bluetooth phones).

2 Charge FreeSpeak

FreeSpeak is rechargeable and must be charged before use.

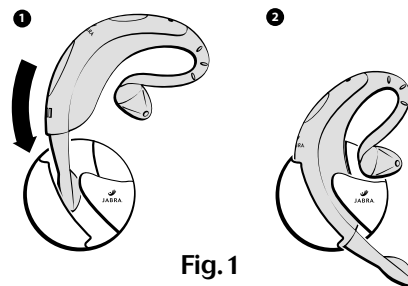

1. Insert the headset fully into its charging cradle.
 2. Plug one end of the AC power adapter into the charging cradle and the other end into an electrical wall outlet.
 3. Charge your headset for approximately 2 hours or until the blue indicator light goes out.
- !** **IMPORTANT:** *The blue indicator light will be on while charging and will turn off when charging is complete.*


3 "Pair" to a Bluetooth phone

1. Ensure headset is off.
 2. Press  until you see a **solid** blue light, then release*.
 3. Follow your Bluetooth phone's instruction guide to start the pairing process. Typically, the steps involve going to a "setup", "connect", or "Bluetooth" menu and then selecting the option to "discover" a Bluetooth device.
 4. Your phone will find the "JABRA BT200" headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this.
 5. Enter **passkey or PIN = 0000** (4 zeros).
- !** **IMPORTANT:** *If pairing was successful, the blue indicator light will briefly flash rapidly before going back to flashing every 3 seconds. If unsuccessful, the light remains solid, and you'll need to reattempt pairing (see steps 3–5 above).*


* If you have a Bluetooth phone that supports the hands-free Bluetooth profile, see "Enhanced features" section for alternative pairing instructions. Phone-specific pairing instructions can be found online at www.jabra.com/fscs.

BASIC OPERATIONS

4 Turning headset on/off

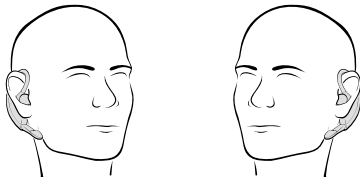
Press the multi-function button  for 3 to 5 seconds until you see a **burst of flashes** on the blue indicator light, then release. *The indicator light will flash while the power is on.*

If you are already wearing the headset, you'll hear a quick series of **FOUR** tones when turning the headset on or off. When turning the headset on, the tones will go from low to high pitch, and when turning off, the tones will go from high to low.

! **IMPORTANT:** *Do not hold the  button down too long (more than 3 to 5 seconds) when turning the headset on or else it may go into pairing mode, and the blue indicator light will turn solid. If that happens, turn off the headset, wait 3 to 5 seconds, and repeat process for turning the headset on.*

5 Choosing wearing preference

FreeSpeak is ready to wear on the right ear. If you prefer the left, gently rotate the MiniGel 180°.




6 Making a call

If FreeSpeak is not already on, turn it on now.


Using phone's keypad

1. Dial number on keypad.
2. Press phone's "send" key.



Using voice-activated dialing (after you've set up voice tags on your phone)

1. Press and release . You'll hear **ONE** short beep while doing this.
2. You'll then hear a tone; then say the name of the person you wish to call.

7 Ending a call


- Press and release  **OR**
- End call from phone's keypad.


8 Answering a call

- After you hear the ring tone, press and release  **OR**
- Answer the call with your phone's keypad, then transfer the call to the headset by pressing and releasing .

9 Call-waiting

- Use standard method from your phone's keypad (recommended) **OR**

- Press and release  once to switch between calls (some phones do not support this headset feature).

! **IMPORTANT:** *Do not hold the  button down too long when making, ending, or answering a call. This should only be a quick tap.*

10 Status indicators

What you see	What you hear	Status
Flashes every second	Quick series of TWO tones — low to high pitch (when active mode starts)	Active Mode <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call in progress • Up to 3 hours of talk-time*
Flashes every 3 seconds	Quick series of TWO tones — high to low pitch (when standby mode starts)	Standby Mode <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Waiting for call • Up to 100 hours of standby time*

* Depending on phone type and usage.

TIPS AND SOLUTIONS

11 Resetting the headset

If the headset is not responding or the light will not turn off after pairing, you may need to **RESET** your headset.

1. Plug one end of the AC power adapter into the charging cradle and the other end into an electrical wall outlet.
2. Insert the headset into the charging cradle for about 3 seconds, then remove (see Fig.1).

12 Tips for Nokia Bluetooth phones

(Such as Nokia 6310 and 8910 series)

Please ensure that the headset is allowed by the phone to connect without authorization. To do this, you must adjust your phone's settings.


Set the following menu options:

- Menu > Bluetooth > View Paired Devices > select your headset, press "Options" > Request conn. authorization? – No





13 Enhanced features

Enhanced features are available for phones that support the **hands-free** Bluetooth profile such as Nokia 3650, 6310, 6310i, 8910, 8910i and Siemens S55. You can enable these additional features by using the following alternative pairing sequence.

"Pairing" to a Bluetooth phone with hands-free profile:

1. Ensure headset is off.
2. Press  and the **volume up button** until you see a **solid** blue light, then release.
3. Follow your Bluetooth phone's instruction guide to start the pairing process. Typically, the steps involve going to a "setup", "connect", or "Bluetooth" menu and then selecting the option to "discover" a Bluetooth device.
4. Your phone will find the "JABRA BT200" headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this.
5. Enter **passkey** or **PIN = 0000** (4 zeros).

Once you're done pairing, the following new headset features will be available:

- **Last number redial** (when not on a call)
While the headset is on, press  until you hear **TWO** short beeps, release immediately.
- **Rejecting an incoming call** (when not on a call)
When your phone rings, press  until you hear **TWO** short beeps, release immediately.
- **Call-waiting** (swapping between 2 calls)
When your phone notifies you of another incoming call while you're on a call, press  until you hear **TWO** short beeps, release immediately.
- **Putting a call on hold**
While you're on a call, press  until you hear **TWO** short beeps, release immediately. Repeat to retrieve the call.
